

**NEW MIDWEST ISO SCHEDULE 2 EFFECTIVE  
BACK TO JANUARY 1, 2005**

On October 17, 2005 the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission conditionally accepted the Midwest ISO proposed Schedule 2 tariff compliance filing effective back to January 1, 2005. As a result, the Midwest ISO will begin billing network customers in the METC zone for Schedule 2 service in January 2006 for the service month of December 2005.

In addition, the Midwest ISO will be resettling Schedule 2 charges based upon their new tariff for the period January 2005 through November 2005. METC is working with the Midwest ISO to perform this resettlement relative to the charges that were applied during that period. It is expected that adjustments will be sent mid to late January.
